- I will remember that the game is for the kids – not for adults.
- I will do the very best to make the youth sports experience fun for my child.
- I will help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation.
- I will teach my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.

Consequences for violating this code may include a verbal warning, expulsion from the field, expulsion from the league, or forfeiture of a game.
